#### Stream Restoration Information Session

A large stream restoration project is planned over the next few years in the villages of Harper's Choice, Town Center and Wilde Lake. The project is being conducted by Columbia Association (CA), the Maryland State Highway Administration (SHA), and SHA's contractor — Ecotone, Inc. CA's goal is to reduce the amount of sediment flowing into Wilde Lake and Lake Kittamaqundi. **CA will be hosting a public meeting at Slayton House (10400 Cross Fox Lane) in the Village of Wilde Lake on Thursday, September 13 at 7 pm.** Residents in Wilde Lake are encouraged to attend the public meeting to learn more about the project.

Similar sessions will be held at Kahler Hall in Harper's Choice on Monday, September 17 at 7pm and at Historic Oakland in Town Center on Thursday, September 20 at 7pm. Questions?
