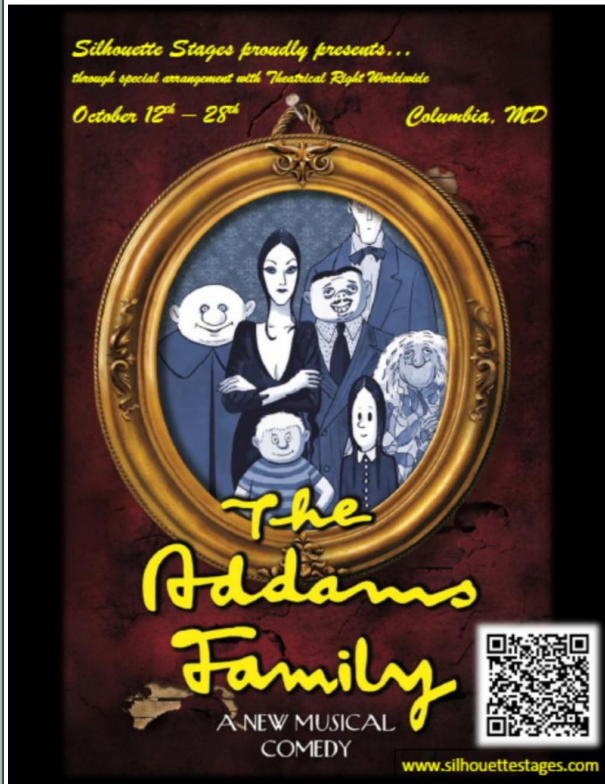


"It All Began Here!" - Wilde Lake e-News October 12, 2018
