### Candidates for Wilde Lake Village Board and Columbia Council

Pursuant to WLCA By-laws section 2.03A, on March 18, 2019, the Wilde Lake Village Board will appoint **Kevin McAiley, Bess Caplan, Stephen Mowatt** and **Laura Torres** to the positions of Directors of the Board for the FY2020 term. *"If after the deadline for the submission of nomination petitions has passed the number of candidates meeting the requirements to be elected Director are equal to or less than the number of vacant positions, the qualified candidates shall be deemed to have been elected by the members and the Board of Directors shall appoint such candidate(s) to the Director position(s) for the term provided for in Article 8 of the Associations Articles of Incorporation."*

**Applications for the remaining position will be available at Slayton House and on our website next week. The deadline to submit an application is Monday, April 28.**

Pursuant to WLCA By-laws section 4.04, on March 18, 2019, the Wilde Lake Village Board will appoint **Nancy McCord** to the position of Columbia Council Representative for the FY2020 term. *"If after the deadline for the submission of nomination petitions has passed there is not more than one candidate meeting the requirements to be elected Columbia Council Representative, the Board of Directors shall appoint such candidate to the position of Columbia Council Representative for the term provided for in Article 9, Section 9, of the Association's Articles of Incorporation."*
