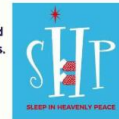

**Wilde Lake Village Center Courtyard Concert Series**

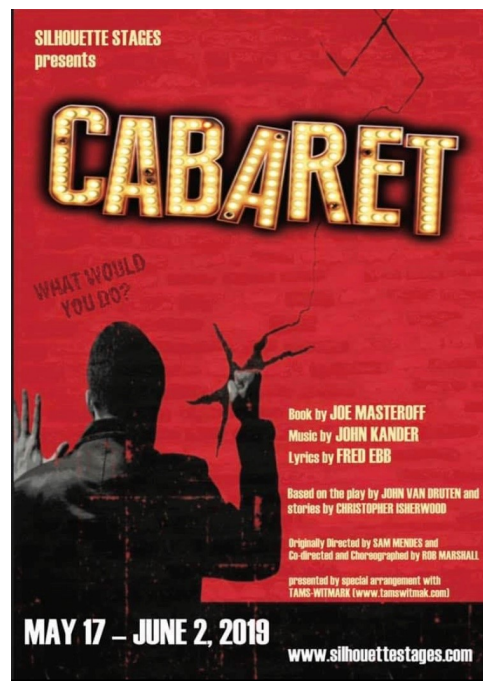
