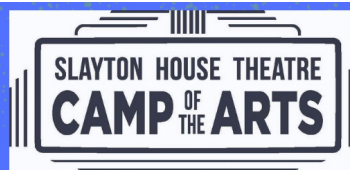

Opioid overdoses have skyrocketed and have become the worst drug epidemic in modern American history. In 2016, over 42,000 Americans died from opioid overdoses which is more than deaths from automobile accidents or firearm-related homicides. In Howard County, the number of fatal overdoses is down but non-fatal overdoses are up. Naloxone, which is known under its commercial name Narcan, can reverse the symptoms of an opioid overdose. Howard County police officers and fire & rescue department's fire engines and ambulances carry the drug naloxone. You can also be educated on its use. You could save a life! All you must do is attend a free drop-in training session conducted by the Howard County Health Department. It only takes 30 minutes and you receive a full kit with everything you need.

Wilde Lake Community Association Seeking Property Standards Evaluator

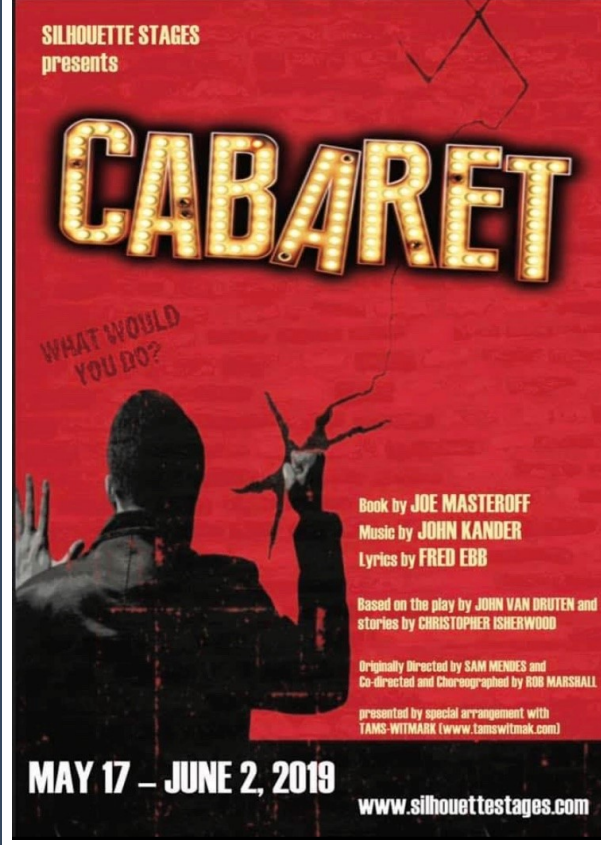
