Prior Experience and Knowledge

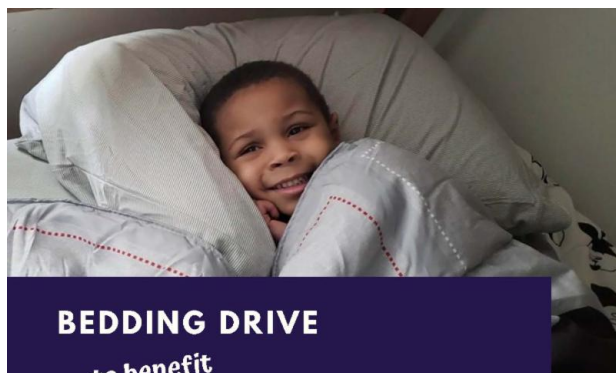
- Knowledge about storm water pollution, policy, laws and control methods

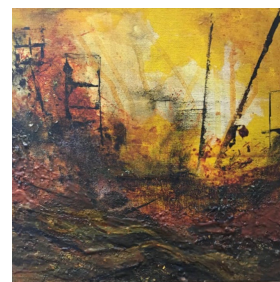
