Grassroots Seeks Meals for People in its Shelter for the Homeless

Grassroots, Howard County's 24-hour crisis intervention center and shelter for the homeless, depends upon the community to help provide dinner meals for its 50 residents.

Many generous individuals and groups prepare and deliver food on a regular schedule, and the meal calendar is often filled. During the summer months, however, vacations impact meal donations. The calendar for July and August is nearly empty, and Grassroots is looking for volunteer cooks to help out.

Meals are especially needed for weekdays. Most popular meals are fried chicken (100 pieces feed everyone), chicken casseroles, spaghetti and meatballs, and pizza (12 large pizzas, any toppings, are needed for a meal).
