Holiday Closings for Labor Day, September 2

Slayton House will be closed on Monday, September 2 in observance of Labor Day.

Howard County Government offices, courts, animal shelter, 50+ centers and the Alpha Ridge Landfill will be closed in observance of the Labor Day holiday on Monday, September 2. Covenants and Our Community

The Wilde Lake Village Board appreciates everyone's support of the covenants as our way to keep our community in the best shape possible. The process for doing the type of inspection that Wilde Lake is undergoing this summer stems from a decision by the Wilde Lake Village Board to use Wilde Lake Community Association funds to hire a Property Standards Evaluator (PSE). The PSE is not a permanent position but rather a position that is filled every five to seven years.

Typically, covenant violations are handled through a complaint process, i.e., if a neighbor alerts the association to a violation, the Village Covenant Advisor investigates and takes the proper means to address it. Or, when someone is selling their house, if requested, the property is inspected for compliance with the covenants and any violations and/or unapproved alterations are noted. The PSE program is just another tool in the covenant enforcement toolbox, but one that is used every so often due to the expense of the program.

Bain 50+ Center Renovations
