Saturday, September 21, 10am -11am, Wilde Lake Village Green (outside Slayton House).

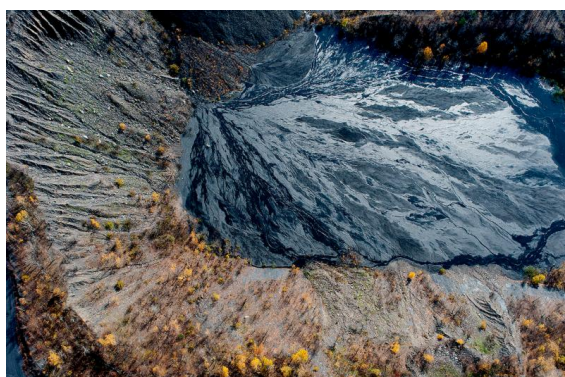
Fall is a great time to separate and move native plants that have grown crowded in your garden beds.
