World Stroke Day is Monday, Oct. 29

Stroke is a leading cause of death and disability around the world. Of the more than 80 million stroke survivors worldwide, over 50 million live with some form of permanent disability. Recognizing stroke symptoms early and getting immediate help reduces the chance of death and disability. Use the acronym BE FAST to identify stroke symptoms.

STROKE SIGNS

- B - Balance Lost
- E - Eyes Blur
- F - Facial Drooping
- A - Arm Weakness
- S - Speech Difficulty
- T - Time - Call 911 Immediately

With stroke, time lost is brain lost, the quicker the response the better. If you suspect a friend or loved one is experiencing a stroke, seek emergency help immediately.
