Census 2020 is Coming Soon!

The 2020 Census is fast approaching. Data collected in the census will inform the distribution of more than \$675 billion in federal funds to states and communities each year. It's important that we all respond to shape the future of our communities.

Be sure to count everyone who lives in your home on your 2020 Census form. It is important to count all people in your home, even if they aren't related to you or are only staying with you temporarily.

Your responses are safe, secure, and protected by federal law. Your responses can only be used to produce statistics. They cannot be used against you by any government agency or court in any way—not by the FBI, DHS, or ICE.

Winter Wellness Tip - Fitness Regimen

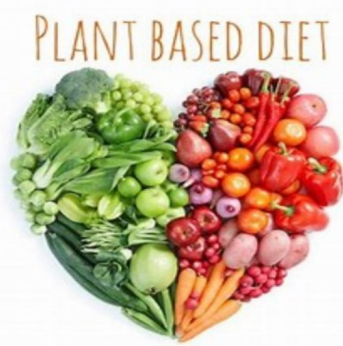
Even though it's winter, it's still important to keep up a fitness regimen. Below are some tips to get moving:

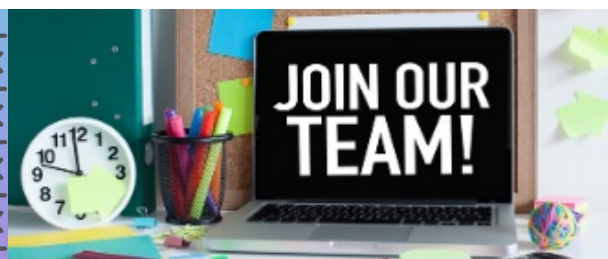
