Wilde Lake has historically been a major supporter of Prepare for Success. We have always had a colorfully decorated collection box. Now with a pandemic and a virtual learning platform locked in place the "backpack" program is temporarily warping into a School Supplies Kit program.

Families are faced with many uncertainties as our country just suffered its worst economic contraction in history. Prepare for Success's mission, for almost 20 years, has been to assure that all students have critical school supplies -- the first step to help them feel at ease in school, achieve higher literacy levels, improve academic performance, and graduate. Recipients of their supplies are HCPSS students who qualify for free and reduced meals (FARM), an indicator of poverty.

Their Fall 2020 school supply list is unique to a virtual learning model and their goal is to assemble a minimum of 3,000 supply kits. This can only be done through our generosity. A tax-free monetary donation makes the biggest impact in their efforts -- allowing them to use 100% of the money raised to purchase bulk supplies.
