## Health and Wellness Tip for October



October is National Breast Cancer Awareness Month

- 1 in 8 women in the United States will be diagnosed with breast cancer in her lifetime
- Early detection includes doing monthly breast self-exams, and scheduling regular clinical breast exams and mammograms
- Men get breast cancer too; it is estimated that each year approximately 2,190 men will be diagnosed with breast cancer and 410 will die
- A nutritious, low-fat diet (30 grams or less) with plenty of fruits and green and orange vegetables can help reduce the risk of developing breast cancer. A high-fat diet increases the risk because fat triggers estrogen production that can fuel tumor growth

## Running Brook Elementary School Fall Pumpkin Sale

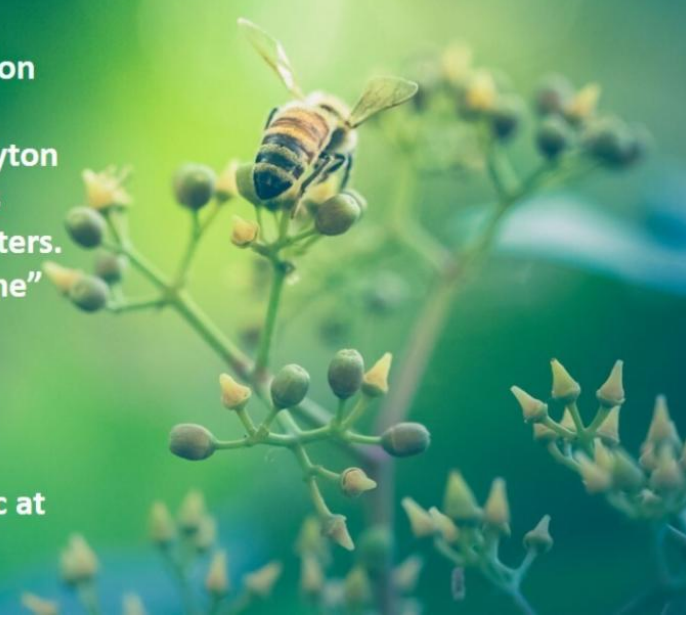

## WHAT WE'RE DOING TO KEEP YOU SAFE



### MANDATORY MASKS

All employees and guests must wear face coverings inside the building.



### UPGRADED VENTILATION SYSTEMS

Air purifying fans with UV light filters in all rooms. HVAC systems adjusted to increase air turnover rate.



### ENHANCED CLEANING

Special attention to touch points. Thorough cleaning after every event. Disinfectant and paper towels available.



### ENHANCED PAYMENT OPTIONS

Contract payments will be processed online via Xpress-pay and PayPal.



### 6' PHYSICAL DISTANCING

Tables & chairs are set up 6 feet apart. Physical distancing reminders posted throughout the building.



### ONLINE PURCHASES

Resale packets must be ordered and purchased online.



### EMPLOYEE HEALTH

Mandatory self-screening prior to entering the building to begin work shifts. Employees required to stay home, if ill.



### PROTECTIVE SUPPLIES

Hand sanitizer dispensers installed throughout the building. Protective panel at desk.
