Health and Wellness Tip for November

November is National Diabetes Awareness Month. One way to avoid and/or manage diabetes is by maintaining a health weight

Managing your weight is a balancing act To lose weight, adults should use more calories than they take in from food and beverages. To maintain your weight, balance the calories you take in with the calories you use through physical activity and other activities.

Tips to help you be active and eat healthy:

To reach a healthy weight, adults should be active at least 2½ hours a week.
Set goals like walking briskly for 10 minutes, 3 days a week, and build up the amount of time you walk.
Take control of the type and amount of food you eat and drink.
Try to replace foods high in sugar, salt, and solid fats (such as butter) with fruits, vegetables, whole grains, low-fat protein foods, and fat-free or low-fat dairy foods.

Following a healthy eating plan and being physically active may help you manage your weight and maintain a healthy lifestyle.
