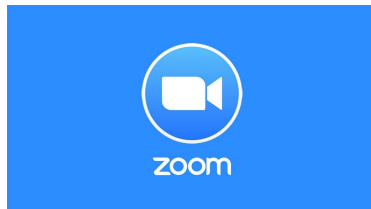
### **Highlights of May 3, 2021 Wilde Lake Village Board Meeting**
