**Columbia Housing Center Hires
First Executive Director**

The Columbia Housing Center is excited to welcome Andrew Masters as its first executive director. Andy comes to the Housing Center from managing strategic partnerships in Knowledge, Impact, and Strategy at Enterprise Community Partners, a nonprofit housing organization founded by Columbia's visionary developer James Rouse and his wife Patty Rouse in 1982. Organized by the late Jane Dembner, a team of members of Leadership Howard County founded the Columbia Housing Center in 2017 to champion and sustain thriving, racially integrated communities in and around Columbia, Maryland. The Center's approach is modeled on that of the Oak Park Regional Housing Center, which has nurtured and preserved that suburb on the west side of Chicago as a racially diverse and prosperous village for nearly 50 years. The Columbia Housing Center will market all villages and communities in Columbia and will promote racial integration primarily through a new apartment referral service.

This significant step toward the Columbia Housing Center's launch – planned for the coming year – is made possible by many individual donors and by support from the Howard County Department of Housing and Community Development's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. 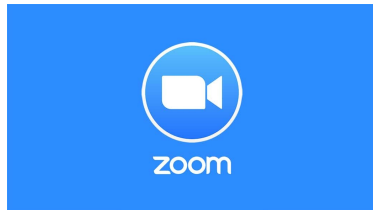
