December Health & Wellness Tips



Have you gotten your flu shot yet? If you have, congratulations on taking the step to keep yourself and others safe this winter season! If you have not received one, there are many opportunities to receive one at local pharmacies, your doctor's office or flu clinics in the county. Other ways to keep yourself healthy during flu season include:

- Wash your hands frequently with soap and water, or use hand sanitizer
- Cover your mouth when coughing or sneezing, preferably with the inside of your arm rather than your hand
- Avoid touching your face
- Disinfect surfaces that may be contaminated
- Avoid being around sick people if possible

- Use last year's cards as this year's gift tags

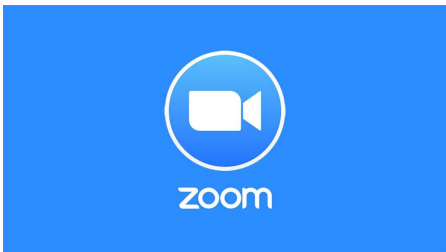
