



2023 WILDE LAKE VILLAGE ELECTION INFORMATION

It's time to elect the Wilde Lake representative to the Columbia Council! Your vote is crucial and needed, and we urge you to participate in the election. Absentee ballots have been sent to all residents in the Village. Who Can Vote? Members in good standing as of March 1, 2023, shall be eligible to vote. Members are defined in the Wilde Lake Community Association By-laws as Owners and Tenants. Where property is jointly owned, only one vote is permitted. Where property is rented, one owner vote and one tenant vote are permitted. Tenants must have a current lease on file with Wilde Lake Community Association to cast a ballot. Email lease to wlca@wildelake.org.

How to Vote? Members have three (3) options to cast their ballots (see below). Residents who live in rental apartments or condos/townhouses/detached houses that they do not own must have a copy of a current lease on file with Wilde Lake Community Association to cast a ballot.

ONLINE VOTING – Look for the unique PIN above your address on the absentee ballot. Once you have your PIN, go to <https://elections.intelliscaninc.net/s3/wlca2023>, enter your code and vote. The online voting system will be open until 4:00 p.m. on Friday, April 21, 2023.

ABSENTEE VOTING – Absentee ballots are valid only if filled out, including all information on the absentee ballot certification. This information will be detached and kept separately from the actual ballot to insure privacy.

Completed absentee ballots may be returned by USPS mail using the enclosed postage paid envelope or dropped off at Slayton House (10400 Cross Fox Lane, Columbia 21044). Absentee ballots are due Friday, April 21, 2023, by 4:00 p.m. Absentee ballots cannot be used on election day.

IN PERSON VOTING – Saturday, April 22, 2023, from 10:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. Look for the voting table outside the front entrance to Slayton House. (In case of inclement weather, we will be inside.) You must show a valid driver's license, a photo ID or utility bill with your name & current address.
