## **How to Report a Problem to the County**

- <u>Tell HoCo</u>: An easy way to report issues concerning potholes, graffiti, sidewalks, roadways, traffic signals, signs, sewer or water, parks, or trees. Download the app to your mobile device or access it on the County website.
- **Damaged cable boxes**: Contact the Office of Cable Administration at 410/313-3318 or use online complaint form.
- **Graffiti**: Use <u>Tell HoCo</u> or contact the police non-emergency number (410/313-2200).
- Road condition, sidewalk, storm drainage or street tree problems: Use <u>Tell HoCo</u> or contact Department of Public Works Highways Operations Division at <u>highways@howardcountymd.gov</u> or 410/313-7450.
- Traffic signal, intersection safety, traffic calming or mistimed signal concerns: Use <u>Tell HoCo</u> or contact Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Division at <u>traffic@howardcountymd.gov</u> or 410/313-2430.
- Sign Complaints: Complete <u>online report form</u> or contact the Department of Inspections, Licenses & Permits Sign Code Inspector at <u>bsaucedo@howardcountymd.gov</u> or 410/313-1831.
