## WILDE LAKE CUL-DE-SAC BEAUTIFICATION PROGRAM

In 2000, the Wilde Lake Village Board established a cul-de-sac beautification program in order to improve the streetscape and encourage neighborhood cooperation & community spirit.

Wilde Lake residents who participate in the program are eligible for reimbursement up to \$200 for plants and other materials used to beautify the cul-de-sac. Ongoing maintenance of the cul-de-sac will continue to be the responsibility of the adjoining properties and related expenses for maintaining are not eligible for reimbursement.

In order to qualify for the program, residents must:

- 1. Complete the Cul-de-Sac Beautification Program Application Form, including a detailed planting scheme for the cul-de-sac showing the location and list of specific plantings. The use of non-invasive and native plants is highly encouraged. In addition, the County discourages plantings too close to the curb (i.e. within 8-10 feet).
- 2. Obtain the approving signatures of 80% of those residents who live within view of the cul-de-sac.
- 3. Submit the completed application to the Village office for review and approval by the Wilde Lake Village Board. Once approved, the Village office will submit the information to Howard County Department of Public Works for review. (Please note that the plan must be approved by the Village Board and the County before work begins.) The Village office will notify residents of the County's decision.
- 4. Submit receipts to the Village office for reimbursement at the completion of the project. Applications will be considered once every five years.
