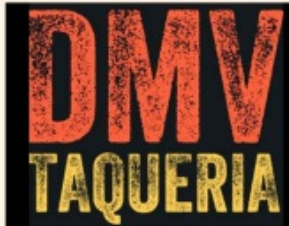

Do You Know About Tell HoCo?

Are you familiar with Tell HoCo, the country's app to report non-emergency issues in Wilde Lake and beyond?

Tell HoCo permits residents and others to report issues including potholes, graffiti, tree damage, stray animals, and more from any smartphone, tablet, or desktop computer. Simply put in the address of the issue, select the applicable request category from the over 30 categories available, and add as much detail as you can. You can choose to submit anonymously or to

follow along as the county processes your request. Of course, WLCA always welcomes resident concerns - but Tell HoCo can be a first step if you notice something when Slayton House is closed. We thank you for being the eyes and ears of our village!

For homeowners at least 65 years old with combined household income that does not exceed 500% of Federal poverty guidelines for a household of two (or \$98,600 for the 2022 calendar year) and combined household net worth less than \$500,000.

Credit amount is 25% after applying the Homeowner Credit and is calculated after all other credits have been applied.
