June Health & Wellness



Alzheimer's disease symptoms cause more than just forgetfulness. It's the leading cause of cognitive (mental) decline in the Western world. Over 30 million people worldwide live with this type of dementia. These include more than 6 million Americans over the age of 65.

Risk Factors for Alzheimer's Disease: Known risk factors for this brain illness include:

- Age (usually around 65 or older)
- Depression
- Diabetes
- Heart disease
- High blood pressure
- High cholesterol
- Higher levels of homocysteine, an amino acid or chemical used by your body to make proteins
- Higher maternal age at the time of your birth

- Obesity
- Smoking nicotine
- Stroke
- Traumatic brain injury

How to Prevent Alzheimer's Disease: There's no absolute way to prevent it. Lifestyle strategies may ease Alzheimer's disease symptoms, help you live longer and lower your overall risk for the disease.

Try to:

- Engage your mind with stimulating activities (e.g., play musical instruments, read intriguing articles or books or work on crossword puzzles).
- Follow a nutritious eating plan that supports a healthy weight (e.g., <u>Mayo Clinic diet</u>) and your heart and blood vessel health (e.g., Mediterranean-DASH Intervention for Neurodegenerative Delay [MIND] diet)
- Keep your social calendar active and interact with others often
- Maintain healthy blood sugar, blood pressure and cholesterol levels
- Quit or never start smoking nicotine products
- Work your heart with 30 minutes or more or aerobic (cardio) exercise at least five days a week (e.g., dancing, swimming, or walking at a brisk pace)
