A Few Covenant Reminders for Fall

The weather has cooled, the trees are turning, pumpkins and cobwebs have come out in force. Fall is here in Wilde Lake!

As we turn the corner into the new season, a few autumnal reminders from the Wilde Lake Village Covenants and the Architectural Guidelines and Maintenance Standards:

- ☐ Leave your leaves. Literally – you can leave or rake them below trees and in garden beds, mow over them to fertilize your lawn, or compost them at home or at Alpha Ridge Landfill. If you prefer to collect your leaves, please use Howard County-approved brown paper lawn waste bags for curbside collection.
- ☐ Please put those Halloween decorations up! But any Halloween-specific decorations should be removed by November 15, 2023. (Seasonal fall décor can remain on display until winter comes along.)
- ☐ Keep your trash receptacles out of sight. A reminder that trash, recycling, and compost bins should not be visible from the street unless it is your collection day.
- ☐ Have a wood-burning fireplace or stove? Make sure your firewood delivery is stacked neatly and inconspicuously. No tarps, please.

Please put those Halloween decorations up! But any Halloween-specific decorations should be removed by November 15, 2023. (Seasonal fall décor can remain on display until winter comes along.)


