

Letters of Compliance

A Letter of Compliance documents that a given property is compliant as of a certain date with the Wilde Lake Village Covenants, the legally binding document that enables architectural control of all properties within the Village of Wilde Lake. Because the Covenants "run with the land," any issues that exist at the time a property is transferred become the responsibility of the new owners to fix.

If you are considering selling your home, please request a compliance inspection as soon as you can. Although the inspection results are generally available within five (5) business days of your request, additional time may be required to remedy any issues that surface before a letter of full compliance is issued.

Property owners may request a Letter of Compliance at any time using the form on WLCA's website:


Request for Letter of Compliance. There is no fee for either the inspection or for the letter.


