The Family Home Start program provides housing assistance to families that are experiencing homelessness and that have children in Howard County public schools.



Depending on family need:

- · Housing search resources
- · First month's rent

3 Eligibility Requirements

- 1. You have one or more children enrolled in Howard County public schools.
- 2. You are experiencing homelessness as defined here: https://bit.ly/3SejBhs Ask your Pupil Personnel Worker for details.
- 3. You earn between 40-60% of Howard County median income:

Minimum	\$ 41,456	\$ 46,638	\$ 51,820	\$ 55,965	\$ 60,111	\$ 64,256	\$ 68,402

Example: A family of 3 must earn between \$46,638 and \$69,956 annually.


